

Course Title: Palliative Care: Core Competencies

Duration: 6 Weeks

Format: Hybrid (Online + In-Person)

Overview:

Palliative care, earlier considered to be a niche speciality, has now come into the forefront with the importance of pain management, good communication and state government incorporation of advanced care directives. Corporate hospitals, government healthcare organisations are now actively setting up palliative services.

The Palliative Care Core Competencies programme is designed to equip both palliative care (PC) and non-PC physicians with essential knowledge and skills in palliative care. This hybrid course combines online learning with an in-person workshop on communication and an observership with leading palliative care physicians.

Course Goals:

To enable physicians to start competent and good quality Palliative care clinics and Palliative care services in their areas of practice and meet the unmet needs of palliative care of their local population.

Course Objectives:

- 1. **Understand the Principles of Palliative Care**: Provide a solid foundation in the basics of palliative care, including pain management, symptom control, and psychosocial support.
- 2. **Develop Effective Communication Skills**: Train participants in crucial communication techniques for delivering bad news and conducting serious



illness conversations. The course will use established protocols and guides for training during the 1-day workshop

3. **Field Experience**: The course includes a 15-day Observer program under the able guidance of experienced palliative care physicians.

Course Components:

1. Weekly Online Sessions (2 hours, once a week)

Duration: 6 weeks

Format: Live webinars with interactive Q&A

Content Outline:

- Week 1: Introduction to Palliative Care: History and Principles, Introduction to pain
- Week 2: Deep dive into pain Management: Assessment and Treatment, including opioid stewardship
- Week 3: Symptom Management: respiratory, neurological and GI
- Week 4: Psychosocial and Spiritual Support, Integrating palliative care in different settings, essential nursing issues
- Week 5: Ethical and Legal Issues in Palliative Care, Advanced Care Planning and Living Will
- Week 6: End of life care and emergencies in palliative care

2. In-Person Workshop (Full Day)

- o Focus: Communication Techniques
- Components:
 - Morning Session:
 - **SPIKES Protocol**: A structured approach to breaking bad news
 - Role-Playing Exercises: Simulated patient interactions in small groups
 - Afternoon Session:
 - Serious Illness Conversation Guide: Framework for discussing prognosis, goals, and care preferences. This will be done in small groups



■ **Group Discussions and Feedback**: Reflective practice and peer feedback

3. Observer Program (15 Days)

- o **Duration**: Flexible scheduling within the 6-week course timeframe
- o Location: Partnered hospitals and palliative care centers in India
- Experience:
 - **Shadowing**: Participants will shadow a palliative care physician during their daily routines
 - Hands-On Practice: Engage in patient assessments, symptom management, and family meetings under supervision
 - Reflection Sessions: Regular debriefs to discuss learning experiences and challenges

Target Audience:

- Palliative Care Physicians
- Healthcare professionals/ specialists interested in incorporating palliative care into their practice

Minimum Enrolment Requirements:

- MBBS
- MD/ DNB: Palliative medicine
- Medical, Radiation oncology

Evaluation and Certification:

• Evaluation Methods:



- o Participation in weekly online sessions
- Performance in role-playing exercises and workshops
- Observership feedback from supervising physicians
- **Certification**: Participants will receive a certificate of completion upon fulfilling all course requirements
